

# New Entry Requirement for Israel Starting January 1, 2025

## ETA Required Starting January 1, 2025

- All visa-exempt travelers must obtain an Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) before arriving in Israel.
  - Without an ETA, entry will not be allowed.

## Passport Expiry Requirements

- If You Need an Entry Visa:

**Passport must be valid for 6 months beyond arrival date.**

- If You Are Visa-Exempt and Need an ETA:

**Passport must be valid for 3 months beyond arrival date.**

- Check Your Passport Expiry Date:
  - Ensure your passport meets the required validity for your entry type.
  - If Your Passport is Expiring Soon, renew it before applying for an ETA or entry visa.
