During emergencies, the Association activates established emergency response protocols for members and their clients. Members operate rapid response teams in full coordination with official bodies to ensure immediate and professional support during crisis situations.

### **Financial Security**

Association membership requires meeting financial eligibility criteria, as specified in the Association's bylaws, to ensure financial stability. Members operate with complete transparency and integrity in all financial transactions, safeguarding client interests at all times.

### **Data Privacy**

Members are committed to strict adherence to all applicable data privacy regulations. We implement robust security protocols to protect personal information and are dedicated to preventing data breaches while maintaining absolute client confidentiality.





#### **Dispute Resolution Framework**

The Association provides members with a professional arbitration framework for dispute resolution. Members may offer clients arbitration options under Israeli law. We emphasize early identification and equitable resolution of any disagreements.
